As a result of interest expressed by boys and parents, plans are now going ahead to offer a trip to London in July 2017. The following information is available at present:

DATES

The party would leave early on Sunday 16th July, returning late (midnight!) on Friday 21st July.

ACCOMMODATION

5 nights bed and breakfast in BB Headquarters, Felden Lodge, Hemel Hempstead (view it on the BB website). Rooms of 2 – 4 persons, all en-suite will be provided.

MEALS

A breakfast will be provided. Daily, the boys will be given a packed lunch and evening meals will be a choice from MacDonald's, KFC, a Food Court etc.

TRANSPORT

The party will travel to London with Maynes Coaches. The coach will be available for the duration of the trip.

ACTIVITIES

During the 5 days, boys will visit Legoland (Windsor), Thorpe Park, a football stadium (we can have a vote on it! Wembley or Arsenal !) London Eye, a walking sightseeing tour in London – all the usual sights! We will also try and fit in a visit to a swimming pool. It is also hoped that we can stop off at Manchester on the way home – activities to be decided! Itinerary subject to change.

All excursions are included in the price.

COST

The cost is **£285**. Meals on the Sunday are NOT included in the cost. If the trip goes ahead, payments will be spread throughout the session – a savings card will be issued with a plan of how much has to be paid monthly.

Note: The trip is open to boys in primary 5+. **Adults are also welcome** (PVG/Child Protection paper work would have to be completed (not a problem as we will take care of it!). **The first deposit of £40 would have to be paid by 30 September.** If the trip goes ahead this deposit would be **NON-REFUNDABLE** unless on medical grounds.

We need to make a decision by the end of September!

London 2017

.....(boy/adult) will be going on the proposed trip to London in 2017. I understand that if, unless on health grounds, my son withdraws from the trip, I would forfeit the first £40 unless a replacement can be found - the amount increases with time.

I accept that a savings card will be used as a method of keeping an account of what has been paid and that receipts will not be issued.

Parents wishing to be considered should also include a deposit.
