We are again hoping to offer a trip to London in July 2021. This will depend on Covid 19 and its implications. Should we NOT be able to go next summer, a full **refund would be made**. The following information is available at present:

DATES

The party would leave early on Sunday 11th July, returning late (midnight!) on Friday 16th July. These dates are confirmed.

ACCOMMODATION

5 nights bed and breakfast in BB Headquarters, Felden Lodge, Hemel Hempstead (view it on the BB website). Rooms of 2 – 3 persons, all en-suite, will be provided. Adults on the trip may have to be prepared to share a room! There are limited single rooms.

MEALS

A breakfast will be provided. Daily, the boys will be given a packed lunch and evening meals will be a choice from MacDonald's, Toby Carvery, KFC, Food Court, etc.

TRANSPORT

The party will travel to London with Maynes Coaches. The coach will be available for the duration of the trip.

ACTIVITIES

During the 5 days, boys will visit the Trafford Centre en-route on the Sunday, Legoland, Thorpe Park a football stadium in London, London Eye or the Chard, swimming and shopping in Windsor, the usual sightseeing trip in London, hoping to include Houses of Parliament and 10 Downing Street. Please note that this is a **DRAFT** Itinerary and subject to change.

All excursions are included in the price.

COST

The cost is **£360**. A packed lunch would be required on the Sunday. Boys would also have to set aside an allowance for the evening meals on the Sunday and Friday. If the trip goes ahead, payments will be spread throughout the session – a savings card will be issued with a plan of how much has to be paid monthly. Regular payments are required as a number of the excursions require either a deposit or money up front.

Note: The trip is open to boys in primary 5+. **Adults are also welcome** (PVG/Child Protection paper work would have to be completed by the company) **The first deposit of £40 would have to be paid by the end of October.**

.....(boy/adult) will be going on the proposed trip to London in 2021. I understand that if, unless on health grounds, my son withdraws from the trip, I would forfeit the first £40 unless a replacement can be found - the amount increases with time.

I accept that a savings card will be used as a method of keeping an account of what has been paid and that receipts will not be issued.
