Armistice Parade: Please note that only the Company Section will take part in the Community Parade on the 11th November. The Company will again be laying a wreath.

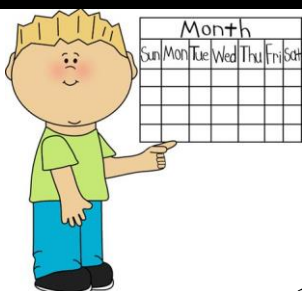
